

# Copyright Statement

## Student Skills Interchange

The following information is crucial to the legal operation of this site and all subscribers/contributors to Student Skills Interchange will need to agree to these conditions in order to sign up for an account. ### 1. Permitted Content

Content which is permitted for upload to the Student Skills Interchange may include, but not be limited to, the following:

### 3. Copyright Breaches
